



Wax your mailbox at least twice a year using a quality car wax. The wax will provide your finish with a protective coating against ultraviolet rays, acid rain and oxidation and help maintain the integrity of the finish surface. In snow climates it can also help protect against salt spray. Rinsing your mailbox occasionally will aid in removing dirt and other environmental contaminants.

If you are installing your mailbox in a wall or pilaster, Gaines Manufacturing recommends, if at all possible, that you make the installation 'removable'. This is to enable, in the unfortunate event that your mailbox is damaged or vandalized, repair or replacement of your mailbox.

Install your mailbox away from sprinklers or re-aim your sprinklers so as not to hit your mailbox. As with an automobile, hard water deposits can damage the fine finish of your new mailbox.
