MAIL SLOTS - DELUXE

Made of brass, Salisbury two (2) piece deluxe mail slots (#4075) are hand-crafted and have the word "MAIL" cast into the flap. Heavy duty tamper proof brass bolts secure the front and back frames to each other from the rear and accommodate solid doors and walls from 1-1/4" through 1-7/8" deep. Each of the castings is a 1/4" thick and are available in three (3) popular finishes. Deluxe mail slots may be used for U.S.P.S. residential door mail delivery.

MAIL SLOTS - STANDARD

Made of brass, Salsbury two (2) piece standard mail slots have a spring-loaded flap for the front of a solid door or wall and inside trim for the rear. Standard mail slots are available in two (2) sizes, letter size (#4035) and magazine size (#4045), and three (3) popular finishes. Standard mail slots may be used for U.S.P.S. residential door mail delivery.
